

GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

1. Manuscripts should be typed in single spacing.
2. Use only Times New Roman, and definitely no other font. The font size must be 14. For Greek, use preferably the Graeca or Graeca II fonts, or the fonts of Bibleworks. For Hebrew, use Hebraica fonts, or the fonts of Bibleworks . If any other Greek or Hebrew fonts are used, please send an electronic file of the specific fonts.
3. Send your manuscript electronically (as an MS Word document) to the editor, Professor Hennie Stander (hennie.stander@up.ac.za). Please also send a second copy of the article in pdf-format.
4. Make sure that an abstract is included.
5. Only articles in English, German or French will be accepted.
6. Authors should use the Harvard Reference System, but footnotes (= endnotes) are also allowed.
7. Footnotes (= endnotes) should be numbered consecutively in the text and typed at the end of the article.
8. Headings and subheadings in the article should be in bold, and be numbered consecutively. Use capital letters only for the first letter of the heading.
9. The editorial board of *Acta Patristica et Byzantina* will accept publications to be reviewed by appointed scholars. For this purpose, books may be forwarded to the editorial address.
10. Please use the following format for the bibliography:
